Only cash payment at the Municipal Office or electronic funds transfer payable to IKheis Local Municipality will be accepted. Tender documents can also be obtained from IKheis Local Municipality at the compulsory site inspection meeting at 11:00 on 06 April 2022.

Tenders in sealed envelopes and clearly endorsed:

97 Oranje Street, Groblershoop, 8850: WEGDRAAI CONSTRUCTION OF SEWER RETICULATION, PUMP STATION AND RISING MAIN TO THE OXIDATION PONDS, must be addressed to the Municipal Manager, IKheis Local Municipality, and must be placed in the Tender Box, IKheis Municipality Offices, Oranje Street, Groblershoop not later than 12:00 on 10 May 2022.

A compulsory site inspection will be held at 11:00 on 06 April 2022.

The Engineer will be present at the briefing and all questions will then be answered. No further visits to the site will take place. Persons taking interest will gather at the IKheis Municipality Offices, 97 Oranje Street, Groblershoop. Tenderers, who do not attend the compulsory site inspection, will expose their tenders to rejection.

Only Tenderers who satisfy the eligibility criteria stated in the Tender Data are eligible to submit tenders. Tenders will be evaluated and adjudicated in line with the Supply Chain Management policy of the municipality using an 80/20 preference points system.

Bids will be evaluated on Functionality:

The bid will be evaluated on functionality with the following criterion:

CATEGORY OF FUNCTIONALITY	MAXIMUM SCORE
a) Performance on Previous Contracts of Similar Nature	30
b) Professional and Technical Qualifications and Competence	35
c) Availability/Allocation of Resources	20
d) Bank rating	15
TOTAL POINTS (N₄)	100

NB: Bidders must score a minimum of 70% to be considered for further evaluation

Tenders must be registered with the CIDB in a CE Class of Construction Works (Grade 7 CE or higher) and have a grading designation equal to or higher than that determined in accordance with the sum tendered or a value determined in accordance with Regulation 25(1B) OR 25(7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulation, 2004

In accordance with Preferential Policy Framework Act, 2000: Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017 Clause 4 (1)(a), tenderers must have a minimum of Level 3 B-BBEE Contributors.

Clause 4(1)(c) 30% of the contract value be sub-contracted out to the following criteria:

- (i) an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people; and/or
- (ii) an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people who are youth; and/or
- (iii) an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people who are women; and/or
- (iv) an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people with disabilities; and/or
- (v) an EME or QSE which is 51% owned by black people living in rural or underdeveloped areas or townships.

A 30% of the contract value that is earmarked for subcontracting would include local expenditure within IKheis Local Municipal area and is not just for construction works.

The sub-contractors must be fully compliant on Central Supplier Database (CSD) and be registered with the CIDB under the CE Class, having a designation in the 1 CE or higher class, as required.

NB: Bids may only be submitted on the bid documentation provided by the municipality.

IKheis Local Municipality reserves the right to accept a part of a Tender and does not bind itself to accept the lowest and/or any Tender. Their Tenders must bind Tenderers for a period of 90 (Ninety) days after Tender Closing Date. No Tenders or copies of Tenders received by facsimile machine, electronic mail or per telegram will be considered. Tenderers attempting to influence the Client about the awarding of the Tender, after Tender closure, will automatically expose their Tenders to rejection.
