The Engineer will be present at the briefing, and all questions will then be answered. A site visit, if required, will be discussed at the clarification meeting. Persons taking interest will gather at the **!Kheis Local Municipality Offices, 97 Oranje Street, Groblershoop**. **Tenderers, who do not attend the compulsory clarification meeting will be disqualified.**

Only Tenderers who satisfy the eligibility criteria stated in the Tender Data are eligible to submit tenders. Tenders will be evaluated and adjudicated in line with the Supply Chain Management policy of the municipality using an 80/20 preference points system on specific goals.

Bids will be evaluated on Functionality and Specific goals:

The bid will be evaluated on functionality with the following criterion:

Tenders must be registered to operate on the Municipality's database to supply goods and services to the local authority.

- Price(s) quoted must be valid for at least 90 days of offer.
- A valid tax clearance certificate issued by SARS for tender purposes must accompany all tenders.
- All vendors are requested to register on the Central Supplier Database <https://secure.csd.gov.za> which can be accessed on the National Treasury website in order to conduct business with them.
- Water and electricity (Municipal account) account must be attached.
- Prices (s) quoted must be firm and must be inclusive of VAT.
- A firm delivery period must be indicated.
- Payments will be made 30 days after receipt of goods. (No payments will be made in advance).
- The quotations will be evaluated in terms of 80/20 preference point system as prescribed in the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (No6 of 2000) with the specific goals as indicated on MBD 6.1. and for this purpose, the enclosed forms MBD1, MBD4, MBD6.1, MBD8, and MBD9 must be scrutinized, completed and submitted together with your quotation.

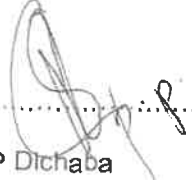
Tenders must be registered with the CIDB in a CE Class of Construction Works (**Grade 7CE or higher - compulsory**) and have a Bank grading designation equal to or higher than that determined in accordance with the sum tendered or a value determined in accordance with *Regulation 25(1B) OR 25(7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulation, 2004*

NB: Bids may only be submitted on the bid documentation provided by the municipality.
